

Instructions for Use of “Araluen” Cross Country Course for Schooling.

All use of the Cross Country Course is entirely at the rider’s and instructor’s risk. This notice must be sent out by the organizer, to every rider.

All riders must be under the care and control of a NCAS qualified and registered instructor, in possession of the appropriate EA Insurance Coverage. A reminder that renewal of Registration is due each September. Unregistered means Uninsured!

Araluen is a working farm. There are natural hazards such as rabbit holes, ditches, fencing wires, rocks, stumps etc which may be concealed by long grass. In addition, there may be barbed wire across the tops of jumps for cattle control. It is therefore the task of the instructor in charge of the group to check for these hazards. Please leave all gates as found – if they were shut, leave them shut, and if found open, leave them open. There are horses and cattle on the property. The water obstacles may or may not contain water.

There are now flushing toilets even when there is not a full scale event being run...everyone uses the unlocked MENS toilets. Please do not ride horses on the Showjumping arena or SJ warmup arena adjoining the Clubhouse. There is no permanent running water at “Araluen” outside of an event, and all riders should bring sufficient water to wash horses down as well as for drinking.

The gate off the Highway (Kardinia Lane) is locked, and the only access is via Golden Vale Rd. ‘Araluen’ has a curving stone fence entrance with a milk can mailbox. Please park your floats / truck on the grassy area between the front gateway and the house. **Front Gates should be closed when horses are left in this area.** Entry onto course is through the side gate. No vehicles or dogs are allowed out on the course.

Cost is \$25 per horse (not per rider!). **Working members of Berrima Horse Trials** do not pay! (This means those members who actually put in time helping at Events or in preparation for Events!) but their names must be included on entry list.

For insurance purposes, all riders must be EA members or BHT members. Names with EA Numbers should be emailed by the organizer 2 days before the booked training day to Berrima Horse Trials secretary tina.stafford@bigpond.com Currency of membership will be check with EA.

The organizer must collect the fees and preferably pay them by direct debit to:

The fees must be paid within 7 days. Instructors who are late in paying will simply not be able to use the course for lessons again.
